ICANN has conducted a review of Neustar's proposed introduction of DNS Security Extensions (DNSSEC) in dot-BIZ in accordance with the Registry Services Evaluation Policy and process set forth at <http://www.icann.org/registries/rsep/rsep.html>.

Based on the information provided, ICANN has not identified any significant competition or security and stability issues with the proposal. As noted in the proposal, implementation requires an amendment to the data escrow section of the dot-BIZ Registry Agreement. The service is approved pending amendment. We understand that Neustar will continue to cooperate and consult with the appropriate ICANN staff and experts on details of the full implementation of DNSSEC in dot-BIZ.
