PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that on July 12, 2004, at 10:00 a.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, in the Courtroom of the Honorable Audrey B. Collins, located in Courtroom 680 at 255 E. Temple Street, Los Angeles, California 90012, Defendant VeriSign, Inc. ("VeriSign") will, and hereby does, move the Court for an order dismissing the purported Eleventh Cause of Action in the First Amended Complaint ("Complaint") for improper venue or, in the alternative, severing that claim from all other claims in the Complaint and transferring it to the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Virginia.

This motion is made pursuant to Rule 12(b)(3) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, based upon the facts that the Eleventh Cause of Action in the Complaint seeks declaratory relief based upon a purported threatened breach of the Registry-Registrar Agreement ("Agreement") between VeriSign and each Plaintiff; that the Agreement contains a clear, express, and valid forum selection clause specifying that the exclusive venue for any claim relating to the Agreement or its enforcement is the Eastern District of Virginia; that the Eleventh Cause of Action in the Complaint is subject to the forum selection clause; and that enforcement of the clause is consistent with public policy and the expectations of the parties and promotes consistency and uniformity in the interpretation and enforcement of the Agreement.
