Changes to Registrar-Registrant Agreements under 2013 RAA

Highlights of Rr-RNH Agreement under the 2013 RAA

- Registered Name Holders must be a person or legal entity separate from registrar (RAA 3.7.7)
- Registrar must use commercially reasonable efforts to enforce compliance with the provisions of agreement re: RNH and Consensus Policies (RAA 3.7.7)
- Registration agreements must contain 3.7.7.1 –
 3.7.7.12 (RAA 3.7.7)
- "promptly" has been changed to "within seven days" in Sections 3.7.7.1, 3.7.7.2, 3.7.7.3

Section 3.7.7 of RAA

- Registered Name Holders must be a person or legal entity separate from registrar (RAA 3.7.7)
- Registrar may be RNH "for domains registered for the purpose of conducting its Registrar Services"
- Registrars who register names under this exception must submit to Sections 3.7.7.1 – 3.7.7.12

- Section 1.19 defines Registrar Services
- Services subject to this Agreement provided by a registrar in connection with a gTLD, and includes
 - contracting with Registered Name Holders,
 - collecting registration data about the Registered Name Holders; and
 - submitting registration information for entry in the Registry Database.

Example:

- ICANN operates a registrar
- ICANN registers the name "icann.com" through its registrar
- "icann.com" is a domain name ICANN registrar uses to provide Registrar Services
- ICANN must submit to provisions in 3.7.7.1 3.7.7.12

- Agreements can be paper or electronic
- Registrar must use commercially reasonable efforts to enforce compliance with the provisions of agreement $(RAA\ 3.7.7.1-3.7.7.12)$ and Consensus Policies
- Commercially reasonable is determined on a case-bycase basis

Additional Changes

- 3.7.7.1: RNH must provide accurate and reliable contact details and correct and update details within 7 days of any change during registration period
- 3.7.7.2: RNH's willful provision of inaccurate or unreliable information, its willful failure to update within <u>7 days</u> or respond for <u>15 days</u> to registrar inquiries shall constitute material breach
- 3.7.7.3: RNH that licenses use of name shall accept liability for wrongful use unless it discloses identity and contact information of licensee within 7 days

Compliance Certificate

Compliance Certificate

- Section 3.15 of RAA
- Registrar shall complete and deliver to ICANN within twenty
 (20) days following the end of each calendar year, a certificate
 executed by the president, chief executive officer, chief
 financial officer or chief operating officer (or their equivalents)
 of Registrar certifying compliance with the terms and
 conditions of this Agreement.
- Form is Compliance Certificate (Table of Contents 11)
