RE: NOTICE OF TERMINATION OF REGISTRAR ACCREDITATION AGREEMENT

Dear Mr. Bourov:

Be advised that the Internet Corporation for Assigned Names and Numbers (ICANN) Registrar Accreditation Agreement (RAA) with AfterGen, Inc. dba JumpingDot (AfterGen, Inc.) (IANA No. 929) is terminated. As explained in greater detail below, this termination is based on AfterGen, Inc.'s failure to cure a financial breach set forth in ICANN's letter dated 20 April 2009. This termination shall be effective fifteen (15) calendar days from the date of this letter, on 25 June 2009.

AfterGen, Inc. is further advised that the logo license Appendix to the above mentioned RAA is revoked. ICANN demands that AfterGen, Inc. remove all ICANN Trademarks immediately from AfterGen, Inc.'s website and business materials that have been licensed to AfterGen, Inc. under the terms of that appendix.

On 20 April 2009, ICANN sent AfterGen, Inc. a notice of breach of RAA based on AfterGen, Inc.'s failure to pay the accreditation fees, as required by the RAA. Consistent with Section 5.3.4 of the RAA, AfterGen, Inc. was given fifteen (15) working days to cure this breach. Based on AfterGen, Inc.'s failure to cure this breach within the time period specified by the RAA, AfterGen, Inc.'s RAA is terminated. For your reference, a copy of ICANN's 20 April 2009 notice of breach and a current financial statement are enclosed.

To facilitate a smooth transition of any domain names currently managed by AfterGen, Inc., ICANN will follow its De-Accredited Registrar Transition Procedure (Procedure)

Please note that termination of AfterGen, Inc.'s RAA does not relieve AfterGen, Inc. of the obligation to pay delinquent accreditation fees, which should be paid immediately. ICANN reserves the right to pursue all means available to collect all accreditation fees owed by AfterGen, Inc., totaling \$ 11,211.87.

It is ICANN's goal to protect registrants from unnecessary harm and we look forward to amicably resolving any domain name transition issues that may arise from this termination.
