RE: NOTICE OF BREACH OF REGISTRAR ACCREDITATION AGREEMENT

Dear Mr. Pahwa:

Please be advised that as of 13 July 2012, Net 4 India Limited. ("Net 4 India") is in breach of its Registrar Accreditation Agreement ("RAA") with the Internet Corporation for Assigned Names and Numbers ("ICANN") dated 14 October 2009 ("RAA"). This breach results from:

• Failure to escrow gTLD registration data pursuant to Section 3.6 of the RAA.

Please refer to the attachment below for details regarding the breach. ICANN requests that Net 4 India cure the breach by 3 August 2012, 15 working days from the date of this letter, by:

 Depositing gTLD registration data on a weekly basis to Iron Mountain Intellectual Property Management, Inc. ("Iron Mountain").

If Net 4 India fails to timely cure the breach, ICANN may commence the termination process.

ATTACHMENT

Failure to Escrow gTLD Registration Data

Section 3.6 of the RAA requires Net 4 India, "on a schedule, under the terms, and in the format specified by ICANN" to "submit an electronic copy of the database described in Subsection 3.4.1 (of the RAA) to ICANN or, at its expense, to a reputable escrow agent mutually approved by Registrar and ICANN."

Our records show that Net 4 India is required to escrow data with Iron Mountain on a weekly basis. However, based on the reports provided by Iron Mountain to ICANN over the past few months, it appears that Net 4 India repeatedly failed to deposit data.

The last full successful deposit by Net 4 India was received on 8 June 2012. As such, Net 4 India has missed 5 required data escrow deposits from 15 June 2012 until 12 July 2012. It is clear that Net 4 India repeatedly failed to escrow registration data and such failure constitutes a breach of Section 3.6 of the RAA.

Below is a chronology of our correspondence and other attempts to contact Net 4 India to date:

Date of Notice	Deadline for Response	Details
1 Mar 12	7 Mar 12	ICANN sent first compliance notice to primary contact smita.p@net4.in to deposit by 7 Mar 12. Registrar deposited on 30 March.
4 May 12	10 May 12	ICANN sent second compliance notice to primary contact smita.p@net4.in noting Registrar missed 4 deposits in April.
1 Jun 12	7 Jun 12	ICANN sent third compliance notice to primary contact smita.p@net4.in to deposit by 7 June. Registrar deposited on 8 June. No further deposits have been made since 8 June, having missed 5 weeks deposits.
