Re: NOTICE OF TERMINATION OF ICANN REGISTRAR ACCREDITATION AGREEMENT

Dear Mr. Tsastsin:

Be advised that the Internet Corporation for Assigned Names and Numbers (ICANN) Registrar Accreditation Agreement (RAA) for EstDomains, Inc. (Customer No. 919, IANA No. 832) is terminated. Consistent with subsection 5.3.3 of the RAA, this termination is based on your status as President of EstDomains and your credit card fraud, money laundering and document forgery conviction. This termination shall be effective within fifteen calendar days from the date of this letter, on 12 November 2008.

Pursuant to Section 5.3 of the RAA, ICANN may terminate the RAA before its expiration under certain circumstances, including when, "Any officer or director of Registrar is convicted of a felony or of a misdemeanor related to financial activities, or is judged by a court to have committed fraud or breach of fiduciary duty, or is the subject of judicial determination that ICANN deems as the substantive equivalent of any of these; provided, such officer or director is not removed in such circumstances."

The attached Estonia Court records state that you were convicted of credit card fraud, money laundering and document forgery on 6 February 2008. EstDomains' has submitted official documents to ICANN that state that you are the President of EstDomains. Absent receipt by ICANN of any document indicating that you were removed from the position of President, ICANN concludes that you maintained the position of President at EstDomains since the date of your conviction. EstDomains' RAA is being terminated based on your conviction and your status as President at EstDomains.



ICANN's records indicate that EstDomains has approximately 281,000 domain names under its management. All registrations sponsored by EstDomains will be transferred to an ICANN-Accredited Registrar in accordance with the enclosed De-accredited Registrar Transition Procedure (Procedure). Consistent with the Procedure, EstDomains may suggest a bulk transfer recipient on or before 6 November 2008. However, ICANN will immediately commence soliciting statements of interest from qualified registrars in accordance with the Procedure. Please contact ICANN's Chief Registrar Liaison, Tim Cole, at tim.cole@icann.org immediately to suggest a bulk transfer recipient.

It is ICANN's goal to protect registrants from unnecessary harm and we look forward to amicably resolving any domain name transition issues that may arise from this termination.
