
This letter is to inform you that ICANN has made a preliminary determination on Neulevel's proposed new registry service.

On 31 August 2006, Neulevel submitted a draft proposal to ICANN to provide for "bulk transfer after partial portfolio acquisition." ICANN requested that additional information be provided with the Proposal. After receipt of that information, on 25 September, in accordance with the Registry Services Evaluation Policy, ICANN commenced its 15-calendar day review period, in order to make a preliminary determination on whether the Proposal required further consideration because it might raise either significant security, stability or competition issues.

ICANN's preliminary determination has not identified any significant competition issues in the Proposal to refer to a government competition authority. In addition, the preliminary determination has not identified any significant security or stability issues as defined in Sections 1.2 and 1.3 of the Registry Services Evaluation Policy. Because implementation of the Proposal would require a change to the .BIZ Registry Agreement, dated 11 May 2001, between ICANN and Neulevel, ICANN has determined to refer the Proposal to the ICANN Board for consideration.

In order to proceed, please provide us with your proposed contractual amendment language by Monday, 9 October. Once we receive the proposed language, we will post the notice of this determination and proposed amendment on the ICANN website.
