Thank you for your letter of 21 December 2017 to Goran Marby and Herb Waye. We have posted your letter to ICANN Correspondence page at <https://www.icann.org/en/system/files/correspondence/yun-to-marby-21dec17-en.pdf>.

As you likely know, the .UA top-level domain is designed for use to represent the country of Ukraine. This type of domain is known as a Country-Code Top-Level Domain or ccTLD.

Under the global policies governing ccTLDs, decisions on how to operate the domain are made within the country by a ccTLD manager. As such, ICANN is not involved in registration policy issues such as accrediting registrars within ccTLDs.
