Thank you for your letter of 29 January 2014. We appreciate that you took the time to write to us, and we have posted your letter to the New gTLD correspondence page (http://www.icann.org/en/news/correspondence/rey-to-icann-29jan14-en.pdf).

On 5 February 2014, the ICANN Board's New gTLD Program Committee (NGPC) adopted an implementation framework for GAC Category 1 Safeguard Advice, and directed the ICANN President and CEO, or his designee, to implement the Category 1 Safeguard Advice in a manner consistent with the implementation framework. For more information, view the NGPC resolution (http://www.icann.org/en/groups/board/documents/resolutions-new-gtld-05feb14-en.htm) and implementation framework (http://www.icann.org/en/groups/board/documents/resolutions-new-gtld-annex-2-05feb14-en.pdf).

In the implementation framework, the string ".ABOGADO" has been classified in the category of "Highly-regulated Sectors/Closed Entry Requirements in Multiple Jurisdictions." As such, additional safeguards will be included in Specification 11 of the .ABOGADO registry operator's Registry Agreement. Please note that the safeguards described in the implementation framework are the minimum requirements for the TLD, but that a registry operator may choose to implement additional safeguards in order to support the public interest commitments of its TLD.
