Pursuant to Section 4 of Specification 5 of the Registry Agreement between ICANN and STARTING DOT (\\\"Registry Operator\\\\") for the .BIO new generic top-level domain, we request the release of reserved Country and Territory Names. These include: i) The short form (in English) of all country and territory names contained on the ISO 3166-1 list, as updated from time to time, including the European Union, which is exceptionally reserved on the ISO 3166-1 list, and its scope extended in August 1999 to any application needed to represent the name European Union, ii) The United Nations Group of Experts on Geographical Names, Technical Reference Manual for the Standardization of Geographical Names, Part III Names of Countries of the World, and iii) The list of United Nations member states in 6 official United Nations languages prepared by the Working Group on Country Names of the United Nations Conference on the Standardization of Geographical Names. \text{Vn}
