- Applicants for new TLDs selected by ICANN participate as observers
 - 5 future sponsored TLDs

- Preparation for IDN workshop on Wed
 - Intensive discussion in the constituency

- Key issues
 - Understanding the funding allocated to strategic objectives and initiatives (security and stability, DNSSEC, IDN)
 - Encourage ICANN to continue develop non-gTLD funding sources
 - Budget accountability and consultative process
 - Lack of public comments on ICANN web site Where are your views???

 - Balancing the need to inform the registrant with solutions which are practical
- Procedure for conflicts with national law
 - Important issue which needs to be addressed
 - Entities operating in countries with strict privacy laws particularly affected
 - Keen to see progress
