### Section 1 – Accredited Registrar Status

The table below displays the current number and the status of ICANN accredited registrars. The registrars are grouped into three categories:

1. **Operational Registrars:** Those who have authorized access into the Shared Registration System (SRS) for processing domain name registrations.
2. **Registrars in Ramp-up Period:** Those who have received a password to the .XXX Operational Test and Evaluation (OT&E) environment. The OT&E environment is provided to allow registrars to develop and test their systems with the SRS.
3. **Registrars in Pre-Ramp-up Period:** Those who have been sent a welcome letter from ICM, but have not yet executed the Registry Confidentiality Agreement and/or have not yet submitted a completed Registrar Data Form.
