8 December 2016 **ICANN** Preliminary Determination Re: Notice of Registry Agreement Termination by ICANN - .theguardian

On 21 October 2016, ICANN notified Guardian News and Media Limited of its intent to terminate the .theguardian Registry Agreement entered into on 30 April 2015. Pursuant to section 4.3(b) of the Registry Agreement, ICANN may, upon notice to Registry Operator, terminate this Agreement if Registry Operator fails to complete all testing and procedures for delegation of the TLD into the root zone within twelve (12) months of the Effective Date.

Pursuant to the terms of section 4.5 of the Registry Agreement, ICANN consulted with Registry Operator and subject to an on-going evaluation, ICANN has made a preliminary determination that operation of the .theguardian TLD need not be transitioned to a successor Registry Operator. ICANN's review and determinations regarding transition to a successor registry operator are subject to the following criteria from section 4.5 of the Registry Agreement, as applicable:

(i) ICANN will take into consideration any intellectual property rights of Registry Operator (as communicated to ICANN by Registry Operator) in determining whether to transition operation of the TLD to a successor registry operator

AND

- (ii) Registry Operator demonstrates to ICANN's reasonable satisfaction that
 - A. All domain name registrations in the TLD are registered to, and maintained by, Registry Operator or its Affiliates for their exclusive use,
 - B. Registry Operator does not sell, distribute or transfer control or use of any registrations in the TLD to any third party that is not an Affiliate of Registry Operator, and
 - C. Transitioning operation of the TLD is not necessary to protect the public interest.

Pursuant to Specification 13 guidelines, given that the .theguardian TLD is qualified as a .Brand TLD by ICANN on the date that the Agreement expires or terminates (the "Expiration Date"), ICANN will not delegate the TLD to a successor registry operator for a period of two years following the Expiration Date.

ICANN's preliminary determination is based on the following rationale:

- Registry Operator has represented to ICANN that it holds intellectual property rights for the name "theguardian".
- .theguardian qualifies as a .Brand TLD.
- The .theguardian TLD has not been delegated into the rootzone, and there are zero (0) domain names registered in the TLD.
