RE: NOTICE OF BREACH OF REGISTRAR ACCREDITATION AGREEMENT

Dear Stefan Hansmann,

Please be advised that as of 13 December 2016, Nanjing Imperiosus Technology Co. Ltd. ("Nanjing Imperiosus") is in breach of its Registrar Accreditation Agreement ("RAA") with the Internet Corporation for Assigned Names and Numbers ("ICANN") dated 26 July 2015 ("RAA"). This breach results from:

- 1. Nanjing Imperiosus' failure to provide records to ICANN that are related to abuse reports, as required by Section 3.18.3 of the RAA;
- 2. Nanjing Imperiosus' failure to validate and verify Whois contact information, as required by Section 3.7.8 of the RAA and Section 1 of the Whois Accuracy Program Specification ("WAPS") of the RAA; and
- 3. Nanjing Imperiosus' failure to maintain and make available to ICANN registration data and records available upon request by ICANN, as required by Sections 3.4.2 and 3.4.3 of the RAA.

In addition, Nanjing Imperiosus has been deemed noncompliant in the following area:

1. Nanjing Imperiosus' failure to timely pay past due accreditation fees, as required by Section 3.9 of the RAA.

Additional Concerns

On 12 October 2016, ICANN issued a notice of breach against Nanjing Imperiosus, which was escalated on 24 November 2016 with a notice of suspension.

By not providing requested documentation related to the abuse report detailed in the Abuse chronology below, Nanjing Imperiosus has failed to demonstrate compliance with Section 3.18.1 of the RAA, which requires registrars to take reasonable and prompt steps to investigate and respond appropriately to reports of abuse.

ICANN also continues to be unable to contact Nanjing Imperiosus through telephone, facsimile or postal mail.

ICANN requests that Nanjing Imperiosus cure these breaches by 3 January 2017, 21 days from the date of this letter, by taking the following actions:

- 1. Provide information and records demonstrating that Nanjing Imperiosus took reasonable and prompt steps to investigate and respond appropriately to the report of abuse associated with the abuse compliance notices in the Abuse chronology below. This includes (a) copies of Nanjing Imperiosus' correspondence with the abuse reporter and with the Registered Name Holder(s) ("RNHs") of the domain names in the abuse report while investigating the report of abuse (including dates, times, means of inquiries, telephone numbers, e-mail addresses and postal addresses used), (b) the steps Nanjing Imperiosus took to address the abuse report, including all domain names in the report and (c) confirmation that the steps taken to resolve this matter will also apply to all existing and future abuse complaints, as applicable;
- Provide records and information demonstrating that Nanjing Imperiosus took steps to validate and verify the Whois information of the domain names associated with the compliance notices in the Whois Inaccuracy chronology below, in accordance with the WAPS;



- 3. In the absence of such evidence requested in item #2, provide the corrective and preventative actions that Nanjing Imperiosus will take, with implementation date(s), to address its failure to comply with the WAPS requirements;
- 4. Provide ICANN with the action(s) that Nanjing Imperiosus will take, with implementation date(s), to ensure that its contact information is up to date, including its telephone and facsimile numbers and postal mail address; and
- 5. Pay all past due accreditation fees.

If Nanjing Imperiosus fails to timely cure the breaches and provide the information requested by 3 January 2017, ICANN may commence the RAA termination process.

ATTACHMENT

Failure to provide to ICANN records related to abuse reports

Section 3.18.3 of the RAA requires registrars to document its receipt of and response to all such reports, as well as maintain the records related to such reports for the shorter of two (2) years or the longest period permitted by applicable law, and during such period, provide such records to ICANN upon reasonable notice. Nanjing Imperiosus' failure to provide ICANN with all records related to the abuse report is a breach of Section 3.18.3 of the RAA.

Failure to validate and verify Whois data

Section 3.7.8 of the RAA requires registrars to comply with the obligations specified in the Whois Accuracy Program Specification (WAPS). Section 1 of the WAPS of the RAA requires registrars to validate that required fields, including telephone numbers, postal addresses and email addresses, are in a standard format or template, as well as verify the email address of the registrant by receiving an affirmative response from the registrant. Nanjing Imperiosus' failure to provide documents and information demonstrating validation and verification of the Whois data for the domain names associated with the compliance notices in the Whois Inaccuracy chronology below is a breach of the WAPS of the RAA.

<u>Failure to retain registered name holder and registration data and failure to make such data available</u> for inspection and copying

Sections 3.4.2 and 3.4.3 of the RAA requires registrars to maintain RNH and registration data, and to make those records available to ICANN upon reasonable notice. Nanjing Imperiosus' failure to provide the requested registration records and data related to the domain names in the compliance notices detailed in the Whois Inaccuracy chronology below is a breach of Sections 3.4.2 and 3.4.3 of the RAA.

Failure to pay accreditation fees

Section 3.9 of the RAA requires registrars to timely pay accreditation fees to ICANN, consisting of yearly and variable fees. Nanjing Imperiosus owes ICANN past due accreditation fees, in breach of Section 3.9 of the RAA.
